Purpose of Guidance Services

- Understand the potential abilities possessed by students and make the best use of those potentials in following and completing their studies.
- Understand the obstacles and difficulties faced by students and be able to solve or overcome them appropriately so that the obstacles and difficulties do not become obstacles in following and completing their studies.
- 3. Understand and utilize the guidance provided to overcome difficulties.
- 4. Understand and apply applicable procedures and regulations that make it easy to follow and complete their studies.

Academic Advisory Function

- 1. Helping students prepare a study plan from the first semester until they graduate.
- 2. Give advice on courses taken in the next semester by understanding their learning needs.
- 3. Give consideration of the number of course credits that can be taken in the next semester based on achievements in the previous semester and declare their agreement by validating the Study Plan Form
- 4. Helping students develop their interests and talents to improve their academic abilities.
- 5. Helping students understand lectures and the benefits of knowledge gained

Academic Advisory Authority

- 1. Give advice to students who are guided.
- 2. Help the academic problems facing their guidance students
- 3. Helping students develop their academic abilities.
- 4. Help solve problems that hinder students learning
- 5. Forwarding the problem of students who are not under their authority to other relevant people who are authorized to handle the problem.

Academic Advisor's Obligations

- 1. Having an understanding of the curriculum followed by the student's guidance.
- 2. Understanding the conditions of the academic situation
- 3. Understand various student activity programs.
- 4. Arrange regular meeting schedules with student guidance
- 5. Establish a good professional relationship with student guidance
- 6. Monitor and direct the development of student learning periodically
- 7. Evaluate the educational programs periodically undertaken by the students they guide
- 8. Guardian lecturers must report to the head of the department, vice dean of the academic affair or dean, if they are going to leave their duties as guardian lecturers.

Student Obligations

- 1. Conduct consultations with guardian lecturers at least four times in one semester.
- 2. Bring academic guidance book when conducting guidance with guardian lecturer.
- 3. Report any academic and non-academic activities that have been carried out and are being planned.
- 4. Reporting academic and non-academic achievements.
- 5. Reporting academic and non-academic obstacles.
